

SPECTATOR CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

A spectator at a Match or otherwise involved in any activity sanctioned or staged by, or held under the auspices of, the Football Association of Singapore (FAS) or an affiliated Club shall:

- a) Respect the decisions of Match Officials and conduct themselves responsibly;
- b) Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, race, colour, religion, language, politics, national or ethnic origin;
- c) Not use violence in any form, whether it is against other spectators, Team Officials (including coaches), Match Officials or Players;
- d) Not engage in discrimination, harassment or abuse in any form, including the use of obscene or offensive language or gestures, the incitement of hatred or violence of partaking in indecent or racist chanting;
- e) Comply with any terms of entry of a venue, including bag inspections, prohibited and restricted items such as flares, missiles, dangerous articles and items that have the potential to cause injury or public nuisance;
- f) Not, and must not attempt to, bring into the venue national or political flags or emblems (except recognised national flags or any of the competing teams) or offensive or inappropriate banners, whether written in English or a foreign language;
- g) Not throw missiles (including onto the field of play or at other spectators) and shall not enter the field of play or its surrounds without lawful authority; and
- h) Conduct themselves in a manner that enhances, rather than injures, the reputation and goodwill of the FAS and football generally.

Any person who does not comply with this Spectator Code of Behaviour or who otherwise causes a disturbance may be evicted from a venue and banned from attending future matches.
